in Spanish. After first gaining a strong sense of self, students are then exposed to a variety of career role models within Hispanic communities. They are encouraged to be active in their own communities, to interview Hispanic professionals, and to explore different Spanish-speaking countries and regions using the Internet. Beginning level heritage-speaker text introduces simple readings that help students who have limited experience in reading and writing Spanish develop these skills. Two-tiered grammar presentation addresses the specific needs of a heritage-speaker class, breaking with the traditional sequence of a first-year course to address disparate skill levels.
