In order to do this, teachers need to know about language and how it works. This book is intended as an introduction to the language that students encounter in the various curriculum areas as they move through the years of schooling, and it will enable teachers to: plan units of work that are sensitive to the language demands placed on students; design activities with a language focus; select texts for reading at an appropriate level; analyse texts to identify relevant language and visual features; create teaching materials that integrate an awareness of language; help students to access meanings created through a variety of media (written, spoken, visual, multimodal); provide explicit support in developing students'
